# A MESSAGE FROM OUR ACADEMIC ADMINISTRATOR




# COMMUNITY COLLEGE: EXACTLY WHAT IS IT AND HOW CAN I FIND ONE THAT WILL WORK FOR ME?


#### JEN BUEHLER

# OCTOBER IS NATIONAL BULLYING PREVENTION MONTH!

Did you know that more than one in five students <u>reports</u> being bullied at school each year? Sadly, this number would likely be even higher if all incidents of bullying were reported. There are various forms of bullying, which include cyberbullying (social



media), physical (shoving, hitting), sexual harassment, verbal, written (including texts), social (intimidation, spreading rumors), racial or ethnic, and so many more. Insight is a bully-free school, and you are encouraged to reach out to your teachers if you are ever bullied here. Additionally, if you are being bullied outside of school, reach out to your counselor who can offer more information on how to handle bullies. Bullying causes fear, emotional damage, stops us from being who we want to be, prevents us from expressing ourselves freely, and might even make us feel unsafe. If you are bullied, say something!


There are two additional factors to consider regrading bullying:

- 1. Bullying involves **An Imbalance of Power:** Kids who bully use their power—such as physical strength, access to embarrassing information, or popularity—to control or harm others. Power imbalances can change over time and in different situations, even if they involve the same people.
- 2. **Repetition:** Bullying behaviors happen more than once or have the potential to happen more than once.

If you are being bullied, SPEAK UP. If you feel uncomfortable with the comments or actions of someone... tell someone! It is better to let a trusted adult know, than to let the problem continue.

- Get familiar with what bullying is and what it is not. If you recognize any of the
  descriptions, you should stay calm, stay respectful, and tell an adult as soon as possible.
- If you feel like you are at risk of harming yourself or others get help now!
- Learn more about <u>cyberbullying</u> and <u>how to respond</u> if it is happening to you.

 What if you aren't being bullied, but your friend is? Learn how you can be more than a bystander.
