Attendance Matters: Where You Belong

Do you have questions about attendance at Insight? Each month we are going to spotlight some common questions that we receive about attendance. For more attendance information, you can

How is attendance counted? Do I have to log attendance? Our system automatically counts your student's activity time in the Online High School (OHS) for attendance. System time would consist of the student working in his/her courses in the Online High School or being



in a Class Connect Live Session. If your student does any work while not logged into the Online High School, you (as Learning Coach or Legal Guardian) can submit an Offline Work Log.

Students are required to login and attend school Monday through Friday. As stated in the enrollment requirements, students are expected to complete a minimum of 6 hours per day which includes completing lessons, attending live sessions and turning in assignments.

My student worked in the online school. Why am I still getting a reminder email/call/text from Parent Square?

The daily Parent Square reminders are based off of a report that is taken mid-morning. A student's name will appear on the report if they have not logged in to their OHS Courses at that time. (**The report does NOT include Class Connect Sessions or offline work**.) The friendly reminder is sent in the early afternoon to prompt students to log into their courses and earn attendance for the day. If your student logged in to their courses between the time the report was taken, and the reminders were sent, you will still receive the reminder. Career Development: From Your Counseling Team


"December 10 is the 70th anniversary of the International Human Rights Day. We want to encourage each and every one to participate in advocating for human rights around the world, let us advocate for one
