
Leadership Lounge

U.S. Military

The United States Armed Forces are the military forces of the United States of America. It consists of the Army, Marine Corps, Navy, Air Force, Space Force and Coast Guard. From the time of its inception, the U.S. Armed Forces played a decisive role in the history of the United States. The military provides advanced technical training in a variety of career fields and also offers opportunities for additional training when you are off-duty. Many military members are able to attend college courses that are often paid for by tuition assistance.






Teacher Tribute


How can I find out which days my student has missed?

Attendance Incentive Raffle:



CTE and Me

Career Technical Education may be your pathway to success

Good News Insight Students! You are in the best possible place to be get a head start on a career that is fulfilling and rewarding. How, you ask? Well, you already know that Insight students are typically able to graduate ahead of their brick and mortar peers due to our reduced credit requirements. Woot woot! You should also be aware that Insight graduates are not eligible for admission to four-year colleges and universities, but they are eligible for applying to community colleges and trade schools. This is fantastic news! Community colleges, trade schools, and apprenticeships are generally faster to completion and cost less (or sometimes even free!). Community colleges and trade schools are also the primary place where you will find Career and Technical Education options.

What is Career and Technical Education (CTE)? Simply put, CTE is the practice of integrating academics with career specific skill training in a wide range of high-wage, high skill, and high-demand careers.


CTE is split into **16 career clusters** that apply to different high-demand careers:

- 1. Health science
- 2. Business
- 3. Sales
- 4. Finance
- 5. Information technology
- 6. Science, technology, engineering, and math
- 7. Manufacturing

- 8. Logistics
- 9. Hospitality
- 10. Government
- 11. Law
- 12. Agriculture
- 13. Human services
- 14. Construction
- 15. Training
- 16. Arts, audio/visual technology, and communications
